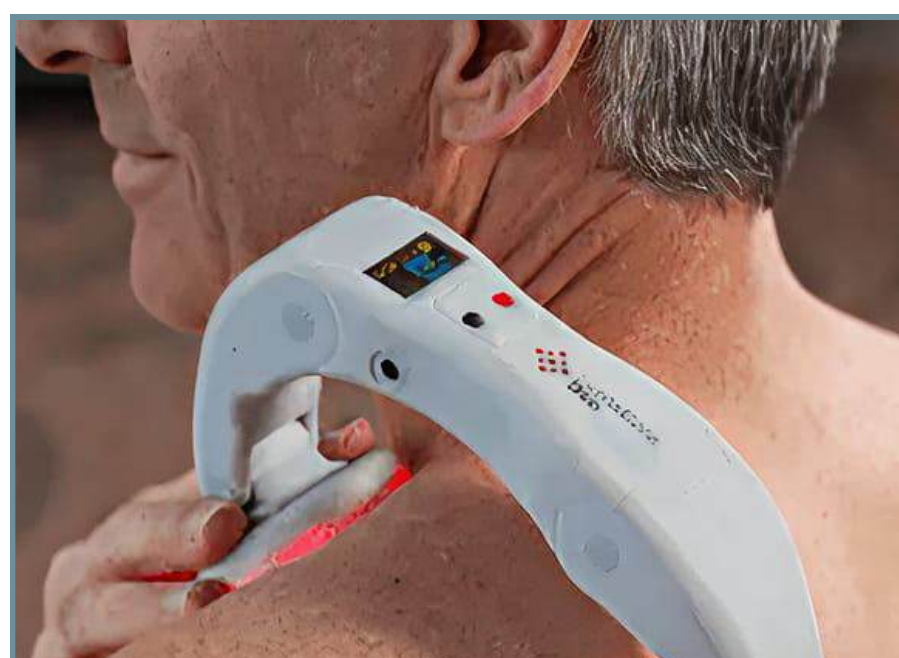

A dual-head device can make it easier to deliver consistent support without extending appointment times. It can also help when you're supporting clients who have multiple areas they want to address in a single visit.

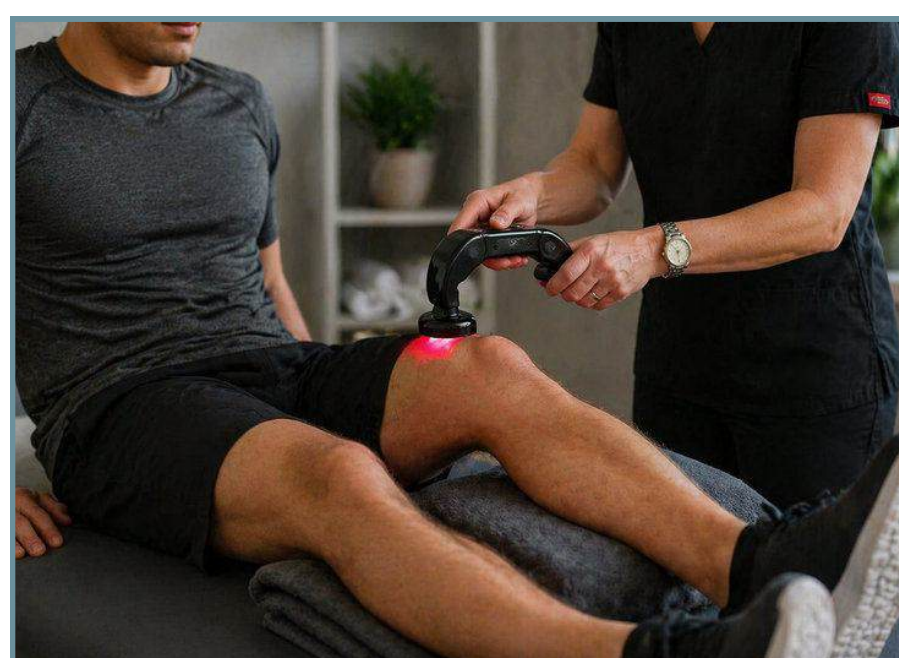


6. Tips to Get the Most Out of the Efficiency Benefit
